Hey Doug,

I wanted to let you know that one of our asset inquiries- specifically regarding the “HauntCon” trademark- came up with some issues. First, it was never renewed after the Clarion sale, and never transferred into your name, so it is now classified as Cancelled and Dead- and has been since October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

This issue at hand is that another organization- Haunt Fest, LLC out of Georgia- has filed a word mark “Haunt Fest” which conflicts with “HauntCon” to such an extent that “HauntCon” cannot be registered with the USPTO.

Unfortunately for you, that means you cannot offer it as apart of your “Intellectual property” holdings that you are selling with the HauntCon brand. You may want to take that into consideration in your advertisement of HauntCon.

We’ll be withdrawing our inquiry from the USPTO as soon as I can get ahold of the office.
